Her coaching records are: volleyball (149-43), including six District Championships; basketball (71-48), with three district championships; boys and girls tennis (17 consecutive undefeated seasons). During her tenure as an assistant high school coach, the boys and girls tennis teams had a 228-41 dual record and won thirteen Conference Championships, nine Regional titles, five State runner-up titles, and eleven State Championships.
