1968 - 1987 KELLY WALSH HIGH SCHOOL (CASPER, WYOMING)

HIS COACHING CAREER CONCLUDED IN 1987 WITH A TOTAL OF 24 YEARS EXPERIENCE. BROCK WENT ON TO SERVE AS ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AT KELLY WALSH HIGH SCHOOL.
