Jim Dolezal graduated in 1987 from Dickinson State University with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Education.

He began his teaching career in 1988 in Mountain View, Wyoming where he has been teaching and coaching for 26 years. He is currently teaching Strength and Conditioning and Physical Education at Mountain View High School. Over the last 26 years, Jim has coached football, basketball, cross-country and track. In 2011, Jim helped coordinate the addition of the first 6th through 12th grade cross-country program to Mountain View athletics and was hired as the cross-country coach. Jim was an assistant High School Football Coach for the 1995 State Championship team and an assistant girls' basketball coach for the 2009 state runner-ups. From 1994-2012 Jim was the head track and field coach. Jim's girls track team has won seven regional titles, two state runner-up titles and three state championships. Jim has been selected as Regional Coach of the Year seven times and Wyoming Coach of the Year three times. He was also nominated for NHSACA National Coach of the Year in 2009 for girl's track and field. Jim has served on the WCA board for six years as the girl's track and field representative. In 2011 he was awarded the Dickinson State University Outstanding Achievement Award in his chosen field.

Jim has been married to Kim for 22 years. They have three children, Sons Cole (Wife Jerika, daughter Ester Mae, son Henry), Kaylor and daughter Riley.
