He started his coaching career at his alma mater, Buffalo High School, in 1978 coaching football, basketball, and track for 3 years. The next 31 years of coaching were at Saratoga High School, Natrona County High School, Midwest High School, and he is currently as assistant indoor/outdoor track coach at Kelly Walsh High School in Casper, Wyoming.

Mark has been a part of 3 football championships and 2 runner-ups, 3 state basketball championships and one runner-up, 4 state track championships and 9 runner-ups, one indoor track state championship and one runner-up.

He has been a member of the Wyoming Coaches' Association for 34 years. While serving on the Board of Directors for 17 years, he was an All-Star representative and an At-Large representative. He served on the Executive Board for 6 years. During those years he was President-Elect, President, and Past-President. Mark was President of the Wyoming Coaches' Association for 2 years from 2006-2008.

Mark's professional awards include the 2010 Coach of the Year for Indoor Track; in 2010 he was awarded the Bill Farthing Distinguished Service Award. He was inducted into the National High School Athletic Coaches Association Hall of Fame in 2014.

Mark's greatest success in coaching comes from knowing that he is following in the footsteps of his dad who was his mentor and best friend.
