**“BILL” BEGAN HIS COACHING CAREER IN 1935 AND COACHED AT THE FOLLOWING SCHOOLS:**

- 1935 - 1937 EUREKA HIGH SCHOOL (EUREKA, MONTANA)**
- 1937 - 1939 GLENDIVE HIGH SCHOOL (GLENDIVE, MONTANA)**
- 1939 - 1943 LEWISTOWN HIGH SCHOOL (LEWISTOWN, MONTANA)**
- 1944 - 1957 NATRONA COUNTY HIGH SCHOOL (CASPER, WYOMING)**

**HIS COACHING CAREER CONCLUDED IN 1957 WITH A TOTAL OF 21 YEARS EXPERIENCE. HE THEN WENT ON TO SERVE AS ATHLETIC DIRECTOR AT DEAN MORGAN JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL, (CASPER, WYOMING) 1957-1978.**
