Wyoming Coaches Association 2025 Summer Clinic COURSE Information

GENERAL INFORMATION – Enrollment in the WCA summer clinic allows you to attend the in-person sessions and learn important content. Your time at the clinic sessions may also earn Wyoming Department of Education Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB) credits OR University of Wyoming professional development credits. PTSB CREDITS – To earn PTSB credit for any summer clinic session, you must provide your PTSB number to **Nicole Costigan** (<u>nicole.costigan@wyo.gov</u>) during the WCA summer clinic. Once the clinic is completed and your attendance verified, the PTSB number you provided will be submitted and your licensure credits will automatically be applied.

UW PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT CREDITS – If you choose to earn UW professional development credits, you must enroll for courses directly from the UW distance education website called WyoLearn. <u>You are **NOT** automatically enrolled</u> for UW credits by attending the WCA summer clinic.
